Manna Food Center began operations in 1983 through the combined efforts of community, civic and faith leaders to establish a centralized food bank for the county. Manna started operations with a donation of 16,000 pounds of food from Giant Food Stores and served hundreds of people. Today Manna distributes more than 16,000 pounds of food daily and reaches nearly 3,760 families monthly. Our founders were driven by the stories of individuals and families faced with hunger and the fear of food insecurity. Today we are still driven by the stories of those we serve.

As we listen to our neighbors, we hear from those who are working two jobs, yet struggling to achieve self-sufficiency. We hear from those who have come to us for food to help cope with a loss in wages or when the bill from an illness exceeded their monthly budget leaving no money to purchase food. Struggling to make ends meet is a daily challenge for families often referred to as the “working poor.” What many people may not know is that one out of three of those who turn to Manna for food are people living with disabilities or seniors on a fixed income. Many of our most vulnerable neighbors struggle daily with the fear of food insecurity while balancing their basic needs on a fixed income like our friend Margaret.

When you’ve lived as long as Margaret Dubinsky, age 88, you learn a few things. One is that no matter what your resources, you always have enough to share. Margaret tries to get by on the income of her social security check. When her \$15 a month in food stamps runs out, Margaret turns to Manna for a package of nonperishable and fresh food items to help her make ends meet.

Of course, Margaret wishes she didn’t have to ask for the help, but she has also learned over the years it is okay to ask, especially when you are willing to help others as you can. She notes that it “Gives you satisfaction when you do good for others.” Throughout her life she has volunteered to feed the homeless through her church. Giving to others now, when she is also in need, is a natural extension of how Margaret tries to live her life, keeping a good attitude during adversity. When she opens her Manna box Margaret sometimes finds items that she doesn’t plan to use-- she is not particularly fond of beans for example. Also she sometimes receives food gifts from family members but recently had too much peanut butter. Margaret puts those items to the side and the next time she is at Manna she returns the bags, cans and jars. Manna pays that gift forward and shares her “excesses” with other clients.

Manna is proud to have Margaret as a role model, inspiration, and friend.

It has been a tremendously busy and fulfilling year at Manna Food Center, and we want to share what good you have helped make possible. In this Annual Report you'll read that we touched the lives of 38,994 Montgomery County residents, sharing 3,905,697 pounds of food. Through our Karen Goldberg Smart Sacks program, we helped 2,201 students avoid weekend hunger. On any given day, 175 of your neighbors received a Manna package at our Gaithersburg warehouse or one of our distribution sites around the County, including a new pantry in Silver Spring.

Looking at our financial statements for the year, you will see that Manna made significant investments in new technology and hired talented new staff. These were necessary enhancements that will help us to do a better job serving more of our neighbors who are experiencing hunger. These investments in our future were made possible thanks to your generous contributions.

Numbers and policies, though, only go so far in explaining the experience of hunger and the strategies implemented through our work. For this annual report, we highlight the stories behind the statistics. Read along as you learn what senior hunger is like for an 88 year old client (featured on the inside cover), who also pays her Manna boxes forward. Meet Victor, who has served on our operations team for more than a dozen years. Learn about our supporters from Mid-Atlantic Federal Credit Union, who designated us as their "charity of choice" this year.

Manna's vision is to be at the center of ending hunger in our community, and we know we can't do the work alone. Thank you for being part of our story and for making our work possible.

Our Amazing Volunteers Contributed the Equivalent Time of 34.5 Full-Time Employees!

Manna has the best volunteers in all of Montgomery County! These amazing people contributed the equivalent time of almost 35 full-time employees helping to keep our costs low and ensuring we always met the daily service needs of our clients. From food drives to distributing food, to answering client phone calls, to harvesting at the farm and farmers markets, to being Manna's voice in the community, to sorting cans and packing boxes, Manna's volunteers do it all. We have dozens of dedicated community volunteers who contribute their time every week without fail.

We are also fortunate to have many amazing corporate volunteer partners. The team at Mid-Atlantic Federal Credit Union (MAFCU) selected Manna as their nonprofit partner for the second year in a row in FY 2014. Not only does MAFCU send volunteers to our warehouse monthly, they are always asking how they can do more. In FY14 the team at MAFCU even purchased and donated a cow to help contribute more food to our programs. From helping with daily food distribution to sending bilingual staff to help with client services, they are a true model for corporate social responsibility. Thank you to MAFCU and the dozens of corporate partners who contribute to our work. Together, Manna volunteers contributed 71,902 hours of service to feed hungry families in Montgomery County. Thank you volunteers—we truly could not do it without you.



The Food for Families Program

The process of providing food to families at risk for hunger is a multifaceted endeavor that involves daily food rescue and coordinated food distribution at dozens of locations throughout Montgomery County. Every 30 days families are eligible to receive a package of food that averages 70 pounds. The package of food we provide includes nonperishable items, fresh produce, meats, dairy and frozen items when available. We are also able to accommodate religious dietary needs, as well as those who follow a vegetarian diet and people who are living with diabetes (as donations allow). In total, Manna shared 3,905,697 pounds of food with our neighbors. In FY 2014, Manna served nearly 3,760 families per month. That was an average increase of 159 households per month when compared to FY 2013.

Grocery Stores, Wholesalers, Farmers Markets & More

Each morning, our drivers visit 50 area grocery stores to “rescue food,” food that is near its sell-by date or produce that is no longer retail-able but still fresh. Manna ensures these good quality foods are used to fill stomachs instead of dumpsters. Last year, Manna rescued 2,098,936 pounds of food. The Karen Goldberg Smart Sacks Program

The Karen Goldberg Smart Sacks program provides food for nutritious meals every Friday for students who may not have another full meal until their return to school on Monday morning. This program not only ensures that these students have access to nutritious foods, but couples this access with recipes, facts, and brain teasers that inspire food preparation and increase nutrition knowledge. In FY 2014, the Smart Sacks program provided 2,201 elementary school children in 57 schools with bags of healthy food for the weekend. The Smart Sacks program is a true collaborative effort; Manna provides the food and coordinates the program, local business and faith and civic groups pick up the food from Manna, assemble the bags and deliver the food to their partner school. The school representative distributes the bags each week to the children participating in the program. Last school year, Manna distributed 82,429 bags of healthy foods. We could not do this without the ongoing support and efforts of our Smart Sacks partners. Thank you for making this possible.

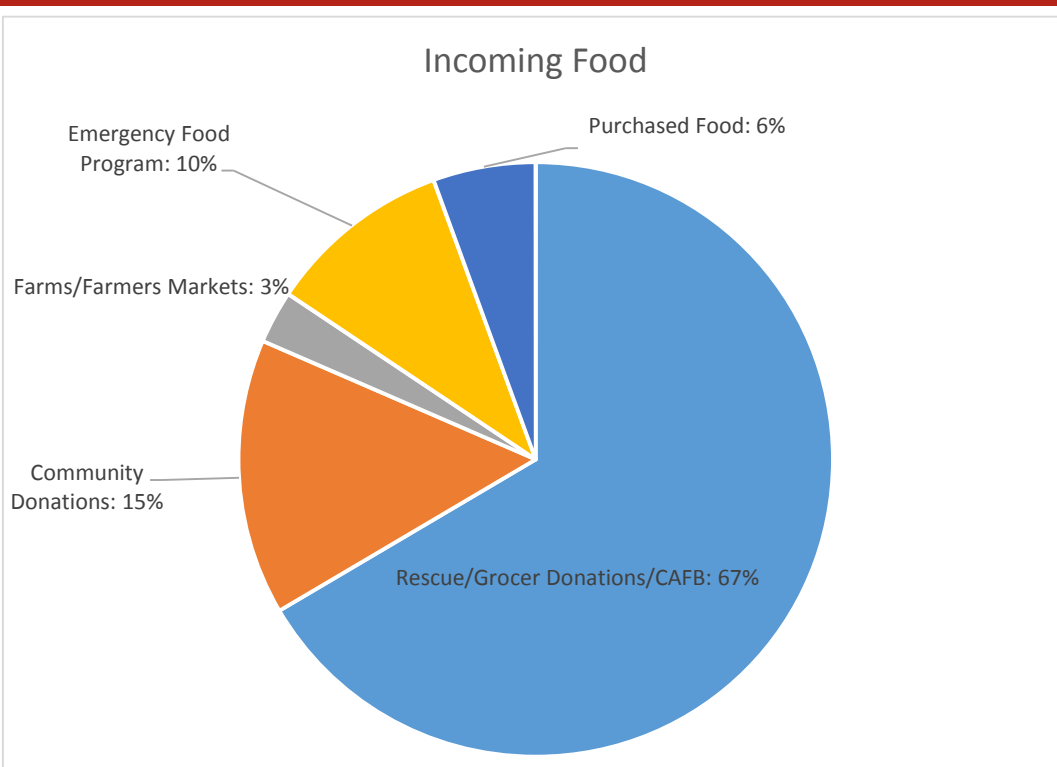
