### 2024 Recap

2024 was quite the year for Farm to Food Bank! Let's take a moment to look back on some great memories.

- Future Harvest Annual Conference: In January, the Food Resources team shared with conference attendees the evolution and current status of the Montgomery County Farm to Food Bank program.
- Healthcare Initiative Foundations' Emerging Needs
   Grant funded 3 MoCo farmers with contract growing
   initiatives. This year, the participating farmers provided
   19,544 lbs of produce to 3 FAPs.
- The Wallace Center's Food Systems Leadership
  Network Activation Grant provided Manna with funds to
  facilitate 5 farm visits around Montgomery County,
  focusing on culturally considerate crops being grown
  locally.
- In partnership with the Office of Food Systems

  Resilience, Manna rolled out a collaborative funding
  initiative. By mid-August, 10 farms were awarded various
  funds for farm operations, with goals of paying back the
  funds with local food items.
